SPIE acquires PMS Sicherheitstechnik + Kommunikation GmbH in Germany

Ratingen, April 13th, 2017 – SPIE, the independent European leader in multi-technical services in the areas of energy and communications, has successfully completed the acquisition of PMS Sicherheitstechnik + Kommunikation GmbH (“PMS”) in Germany, on April 6th, 2017.

PMS, with its head office located in Dresden, was founded in 1991 and covers the entire value chain in the area of security and communications, from design and planning to installation and maintenance of fire detection, burglar alarm and access control systems, as well as smoke and heat extraction systems. In 2016, PMS generated approximately €3 million in revenues with 24 high qualified employees at its Dresden and Chemnitz locations.
