The two companies have already initiated their partnership: Last week, Siemens launched a 50-kilowatt (kW) Compact Power Charger at the Frankfurt branch. As a result, employees, customers and visitors can now recharge their vehicles within a short space of time. Common charging standards, such as CCS, CHAdeMO and Type 2, are available here.

SPIE performed all of the construction work and commissioning for this project. In addition, SPIE is also in charge of technical operations and annual maintenance.

“We are offering our customers a comprehensive package thanks to our dense network of locations and broad expertise in finding the right solutions as a multi-technical service provider.
